



Seasonal CSA

MEMBERSHIP CONTRACT

For those who do not want to commit to an entire CSA season, Snead's Farm introduces Seasonal CSA plans. These CSA shares will be offered for pickup at Snead's Farm only.

In addition to the weekly box (equivalent to a small share of the Snead's Farm full-season CSA), seasonal CSA members will also receive all of the other benefits of CSA membership during their subscription period. These include:

- Free admission to the farm on pickup Wednesdays.
- The same pick-your-own opportunities that are offered to full-season CSA members during the period of seasonal membership.

SPRING CSA

- **Pickup dates:** May 11, 18 and 25.
- **What's in season now?*** Strawberries, greens, possibly asparagus, onions, sweet potatoes, eggs
- **Price:** \$153.75 (includes sales tax)

SUMMER CSA

- **Pickup dates:** July 6, 13, 20, 27; Aug. 3, 10, 17
- **What's in season now?*** Greens, onions, potatoes, corn, eggplant, peppers, melons, peaches, raspberries, blackberries, sunflowers, Concord grapes, tomatoes, eggs
- **Price:** \$410 (includes sales tax)

FALL

- **Pickup dates:** Oct. 5 and 31
- **What's in season now?*** The fall CSA subscription includes two large pickups. The first is our last CSA pickup of the year, a quadruple box that includes a hefty supply of pumpkins, sweet potatoes, apples, eggs and other fall goods. On Halloween day, we'll give you the best of the end of the harvest season, which includes pumpkins, winter squash, apples, tomatoes, eggs and more. On both pickup days, you'll get free admission to our farm during the Fall Festival, with hayrides, mountain slides and other attractions to enjoy.
- **Price:** \$153.75 (includes sales tax)

*While these items are typically in season during these months, this statement does not reflect a guarantee that they will be available. All crop availability is subject to weather, crop yields and other variables that are part of running a family farm.

What's in the box?

Snead's Farm CSA shares include fresh produce from our farm, as well as from Steve Minter Farm and Canning Farm of King George County, Idlewood Farm near Richmond and Braehead Farm of Fredericksburg. These partnerships allow us to offer a wider variety of items in our weekly boxes, reduce the risk to the consumer and promote the success of more local farms.

The contents of boxes will vary based on the yield of fruit and vegetable fields, plants and orchards, and of the laying hens, which depends on the forces of nature. However, Snead's Farm and its partners have enough variety, growing more than 40 different crops, that enough shall come to fruition to afford everyone a good supply of almost everything. All crops at Snead's Farm can be irrigated, greatly reducing the risk of failure.

The Snead's Farm CSA *may* offer pick-your-own opportunities to members for asparagus, sugar snap peas, plums, strawberries, raspberries, blackberries or grapes when there is a plentiful crop; however, Snead's Farm cannot guarantee this. Small-share owners will enjoy the same pick-your-own opportunities as full-share owners.

Pickup: We will use the e-mail address you provide at purchase to send you a Sunday-night preview of your box each week. If you know that you will miss your pickup, your options are to have someone pick it up for you or to simply forgo your share for the week. Cash refunds or share replacements will not be offered for any missed pickups. You are welcome to visit, picnic and stroll around the farm on pickup day, and on bonus pick-your-own days, which are usually on Saturday mornings.
